Begin each day with prayer asking God to teach you, to open your eyes, to examine your heart and your actions.

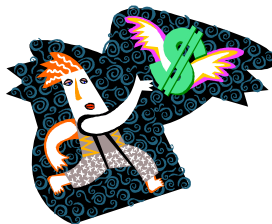
1. Read the selection from Proverbs.
