

# December Morning Watch



Isaiah 9:6 says, "For a child will be born to us, a son will be given to us; And the government will rest on His shoulders; And His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, **Prince of Peace.**"

When the angels came to the shepherds announcing the birth of Christ they sang "Glory to God in the highest and on earth **peace**, good will toward men" (Luke 2:14).

Why did the coming of Christ bring **peace**? How can you have peace? One of the definitions for peace is "freedom from disquieting or oppressive thoughts or emotions". When a country is at war, it is important to remember that we can have peace in our hearts through Christ.
